

PRE-SALE TB TESTING

In an attempt to overcome any unnecessary confusion regarding pre-sale TB testing in respect of the above sale centres, some of which are in a 4 yearly TB testing area, members should check with the respective auctioneers at each sale centre and conform to their requirements.

HEREFORD AND SHREWSBURY AUCTION CENTRES

In respect of all official sales held at Hereford and Shrewsbury Auction Centre **all** animals entered, including calves at foot, must be TB tested within 60 days of the sale.

SALE INSPECTIONS
HEREFORD AND SHREWSBURY AUCTION CENTRES

You are asked to note that, following the veterinary inspection of sale entries, any that are rejected should be removed or returned home from the sale premises by no later than 8.00 a.m. on the morning of the Sale.

If it is not practical to do so, they will be marked appropriately and re-penned in an area designated where signs will be displayed identifying the animals as rejected by the veterinarian and that they are not offered for sale.
